NEW PROPERTY ACQUIRED AT DAKSHINESWAR

Our Dakshineswar ashram has been feeling the need to expand its facilities as the work continues to grow. We have been looking for properties in its vicinity where the expansion can take place. By divine grace, around 7,000 square feet of property adjacent to the ashram was available to us. With your donations, we could acquire this property at the cost of $\stackrel{?}{\scriptstyle \sim} 80$ lakh.

Upgradation of the Facilities

YSS Educational Institutions at Jagannathpur, Ranchi

Four years ago, the Government of India commemorated the 125th birth anniversary of our Gurudeva, Paramahansa Yogananda, in recognition of his spiritual stature and his timeless contributions to spreading the science of Yoga all over the world. As one of

the several initiatives that were sanctioned under this project, a sum of ₹8 crore was allocated for the construction of a new building complex

for the Yogoda Satsanga School and a large multipurpose hall for use by both the college and the school located at the Yogoda Satsanga Educational Institutions (YSEI) Campus at Jagannathpur in Ranchi.

The school and college cater to the poor and needy sections of the population on the outskirts of Ranchi. Many tribal children also attend these charitable educational institutions. Apart from regular courses, students are given training in yoga, sports, drama, and other extracurricular activities. Many of the students are first-generation learners.

Since the existing school building, constructed almost 40 years ago, was semi-permanent and had outlived its life, work began with the grant given by the Government of India and from contributions made by generous devotees.

Construction works completed to date:

- Construction of 10,000 square feet state-of-the-art Multi-Purpose Hall with a seating capacity of 900 on the first floor and five hallcum-class rooms of 2,000 square feet each on the ground floor. The constructions of this building costs ₹3.2 crore.
- An amount of ₹5.5 crore was spent for the construction of the new school complex, which comprised of the following:
 - Administrative Block
 - O Computer and Science Laboratory buildings
 - O A new library building with contemporary facilities
 - NCC and NSS buildings
 - O Toilets
- Four clusters of six classrooms each (a total of 24 classrooms) were

built at an expense of ₹4.4 crore. These classrooms have a unique design that permits plenty of sunlight and ventilation allowing students to be close to nature. The construction of these clusters was made possible by generous donations we received in previous years for the school.

Interiors and ancillary work such as furniture for class rooms and Multi-Purpose Hall, mid-day meal building, cycle shed for school children, stage and acoustics for the Multi-Purpose Hall, electrical panelling, LAN, internal roads, drainage systems, street lighting, and landscaping.

Due to the Covid pandemic, construction activity which had slowed down has now been completed. Our revered President and Spiritual Head Sri Sri Swami Chidananda Giri inaugurated these new facilities on January 29, 2023.

The total cost of the entire project is $\ref{22}$ crore. We received $\ref{8}$ crore as grant from the Government. Several devotees have come forward to support various aspects of this project by contributing $\ref{10}$ crore so far. We seek your help to raise the shortfall of $\ref{4}$ crore. Your generous contributions will be much appreciated.

The Central Kitchen at Ranchi

The dining hall at YSS Ranchi ashram was proving to be small to accommodate the increasing number of devotee visitors and resident

sevaks. The waiting time for meals was increasing, especially during special events such as commemorations and Sangams. We undertook the project to more than triple the seating capacity of the dining area.



Until now, the kitchen and dining were housed in an old building that needed repairs. The renovation of this building was completed in November 2022. In addition to the larger dining area, the cooking



facility has been upgraded with modern equipment to cook and serve meals in a more hygienic way. A walk-in refrigerator and a larger storage facility have also been added.

The kitchen and dining hall renovation was completed at a total cost of ₹1.5 crore and was inaugurated on December 8, 2022.



SPECIAL SANGAM AT HYDERABAD TO BE LED BY SWAMI CHIDANANDAJI



Release of YSS Lessons in Tamil and Telugu




On July 22, 2022, the Tamil translation of the new edition of the *Yogoda Satsanga Lessons* was released by Swami Suddhananda Giri at a special function in Chennai and the first copy of the Introductory Lesson was received by Padma Vibhushan Sri Rajinikanth, renowned actor, producer, philanthropist, and a YSS devotee. The event drew participation from around 1,600 people at the venue, and many more joined via a live-stream.

On December 3, 2022—the auspicious occasion of Gita Jayanti—the Telugu translation of the YSS Lessons was released by YSS monas-

tics at Rajahmundry, Andhra Pradesh. Swami Smaranananda Giri presided over the function which was attended by more than 600 people.

YSS/SRF President and Spiritual Head Sri Sri Swami Chidananda Giri sent special messages of blessings for these events. In his letter to devotees for these milestone events, Swamiji thanked all involved in their release, saying: "Much loving thought and effort has gone into making this possible, and from the depths



of my heart I thank all of those who have devotedly served to bring about this translation and distribution."

Translating the Lessons Into Other Indian Languages





The *Lessons* are also being translated into other Indian languages—Hindi and Bengali. Teams of dedicated monastics and devotees are working assiduously to complete these translations. We have also recruited personnel for the website, typesetting, and Lessons dispatch to support the publication and distribution of the *Lessons* in these languages. This project is of utmost importance, and your assistance is vital to make it possible.

Release of New Translations and eBooks

During this year we released the following new translations of Guruji's books: *Man's Eternal Quest* in Gujarati and Marathi, *The Science of Religion* in Malayalam, *The Divine Romance* in Hindi, and *Journey to Self-realization* in Tamil. We also released *The Second Coming of Christ* and the Hindi *God Talks with Arjuna*— *The Bhagavad Gita* in ebook format.

Many other titles by Yoganandaji are currently being translated into various languages to make these accessible to readers in their native tongues.

- IT integrations to support seamless access across YSS Devotee Portal, SRF/YSS Volunteer Portal, SRF Convocation, online programmes, and more.


Updated SRF/YSS App

YSS Lessons students can now read their Lessons and supporting material on their mobile and on the computer.



YSS Website Translated Into Several Indian Languages



Social Media



hundreds of volunteers, our online offerings help bring upliftment, solace, and encouragement to many devotees—especially to those who

are living far away from YSS ashrams or centres. As part of our celebrations of the 75th anniversary of the *Autobiography of a Yogi*, YSS *sannyasis* led group study and contemplation sessions on this spiritual classic.



Discourses on the Bhagavad Gita

A series of inspirational talks on the wisdom of the Bhagavad Gita as interpreted by Gurudeva Paramahansa Yogananda in *God Talks With Arjuna* were given in English by a senior YSS *sannyasi* Swami Smaranananda Giri. These Gita discourses, now available on YSS YouTube channel, are deeply appreciated by one and all. For the benefit of Hindi-speaking devotees, Swami Ishwarananda Giri has begun giving online series of Gita discourses in Hindi, and he will continue to share more inspiration in the coming months.



Through your kindness, all our ashrams infrastructure has been upgraded to support online activities. These include: creating studio facilities, acquiring video production and archival software, and facilities for digitally transmitting highquality audio-visual content.

Donation of Ambulance to District Hospital, Almora

YSS has been actively extending relief support to the locals in several villages around our Dwarahat ashram, especially during the recent challenging times of the Covid-19 pandemic.

As part of our ongoing charitable activities, YSS donated an ambulance to Almora District Hospital in Uttarakhand. The Basic Life Support ambulance costing ₹16.5 lakh is well equipped with contemporary medical equipment to provide help to patients during transit to the hospital. With the addition of this ambulance donated by YSS; the district hospital can now safely transport local patients to higher medical centres in case of medical emergencies.



Enhancing the Facilities at Sevashram—Charitable Medical Clinic—in Ranchi

Since 1958, the charitable medical clinic—Sevashram at YSS Ranchi ashram, has been providing free medical help to the poor and needy. It includes an eye hospital where free eye surgery is conducted, and a general OPD where specialist doctors provide free consultation. All the medicines are given free of cost.

Because of the high quality of service offered free of cost, the eye hospital has become very popular in Ranchi and surrounding localities. As a result, the daily attendance and the number of weekly operations have been continuously increasing, putting pressure on the existing infrastructure and facilities. To keep up with the growing needs, YSS completely renovated the old hospital building with the help of your generous donations. These included: complete renovation of the operation theatre; new equipment for cataract surgery; renovation of the roof of the building; electrical rewiring of the entire building; construction

of a ramp for the physically challenged; and a new and larger reception area for greater convenience of the patients. All these renovations cost ₹50 lakh.





Flood Relief Efforts in Assam

Heavy rainfall in the pre-monsoon season caused havoc in villages in Assam, leading to loss of food crops, ill health, and extensive damage to houses. Most of the families had to leave their homes and take shelter in makeshift camps or on the roadside. YSS devotees in Guwahati spearheaded our relief efforts in supplying rations and essential items to affected families. "Initially when we surveyed the flood-affected area, we estimated that around 2,000 families would need support," wrote a YSS



volunteer from Guwahati. "But, as we went to the area with our first batch of rations, we were confronted with the dismal conditions of a far greater number of people in these villages. We updated Ranchi ashram, and promptly received help to provide relief to an additional 1,200 families. To do our part

in serving the unfortunate not only helps to bring Guruji's love and compassion in their lives but in ours too; and this is very soul satisfying!"

Flood Relief Efforts in Odisha

The Recent floods in Odisha in August affected about 1.5 lakh people from 201 villages under 55 gram-panchayats in Puri district. Many areas continued to remain inundated with floodwater for more than a week, and residents were taking refuge on roads or river embankments without any electricity supply. YSS devotees of Bhubaneswar and Puri Dhyana Kendras, with help from local school teachers and administration,



carried out the distribution of 716 solar lamps to the flood-affected residents of Gopa and Nimapara blocks of Puri district.

Students of YSS Charitable Coaching Centre get Selected for IITs



Three former students of our Charitable Coaching Centre at the YSS Noida ashram, have got selected in highly prestigious Indian Institutes of Technology or IITs. Rohini Mishra has joined IIT Kharagpur; Yogesh Lodhi studies at IIT Patna, and Anshu

Pal has preferred to join Delhi College of Engineering.

Started over a decade ago, the Coaching Centre offers free coaching to students from the economically weaker sections of society, residing in the vicinity of the YSS Noida ashram. Students from classes IX to XII are taught at the ashram premises after their school hours.

New Dhyana Mandir Dedication

Swami Ishwarananda dedicated a beautiful dhyana mandir at Jaipur, Rajasthan, during a three-day programme on September 30, 2022 — Avirbhav Divas of Sri Sri Lahiri Mahasaya. A sacred Kriya Yoga diksha was also conducted in the new dhyana mandir. The programme was attended by 390 devotees. This multi-storeyed building can accommodate around 350 devotees and includes two meditation halls, book room, Children Satsanga room, kitchen and dining hall, conference hall, and rooms for the visiting monks.


